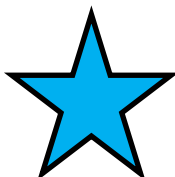

### Physical Damages

Businesses and Private Nonprofits (PNP):

- Real Estate or Leasehold Improvements
- Machinery and Equipment
- Furniture and Fixtures
- Other Business Assets

*Interest rate as low as 4% for businesses and 2.625% for PNPs*

Up to \$2 million

### Economic Injury

*It is not necessary to have physical damages for the Economic Injury Disaster Loan*

Small Businesses and Private Nonprofits (PNP):

- Accounts Payable
- Payroll
- Monthly Fixed Debts and Expenses
- Other Working Capital Needs

*Interest rate as low as 4% for businesses and 2.625% for PNPs*

Up to \$2 million

### Homeowners

- Up to \$200,000 for Primary Residence

*Interest rate as low as 1.875%*

*Terms up to 30 years*

### Homeowners and Renters

- Up to \$40,000 for Personal Property (Including Automobiles)

*Interest rate as low as 1.875%*

*You may apply before insurance is settled and before proceeds are received
